

SUCCESS FOR NSW FENCERS AT AFC#4 IN SYDNEY.

AFC#4 witnessed some riveting fencing and close contests with strong performances by NSW fencers. In open events, NSW fencers contested five of the six finals and in two of them, Open Women's Sabre and Open Men's Foil, NSW fencers vied with each other for gold. The overall medal tally for NSW in the opens was 2 golds, 5 silvers and 6 bronzes. NSW fencers won all 6 veteran golds as well as 5 silvers and 6 bronzes.

An indication of the depth of fencing in NSW is that NSW fencers made up 12 of the top 16 in Open Men's Sabre, 9 of the top 16 in Open Women's Sabre and Open Women's Epee; 8 of the top 16 in Open Men's Foil; 7 of the top 16 in Open Women's Foil.

NSW FENCERS STILL TOPS IN U23 NATIONALS



At AFC#4, NSW was announced the winner, for the third year, of the Charles Stanmore Trophy, awarded to the State whose fencers earn the most points at the U23 championship events held at AFC#1, 2 & 3. The trophy - named after NSW Olympian Charles Stanmore (Helsinki 1952) - was donated in 2016 by one of his former students, Richard Emmerick, and has been held by NSW since then.

So far this year, NSW fencers have won the Frank Bartolillo Cup for U15s and the Janet Hopner-Haswell Cup for Cadets with the big one - the Cyclone Cup - up for grabs at the Australian Open Championships in Melbourne. NSW and Victoria tied for this trophy last year. The Centenary Shield for veterans, which NSW has held since it was first presented in 2013, is also in contention.

'LIKE FLOATING ON AIR'



The NSW Fencing Centre recently took delivery of three new Leon Paul aluminium pistes, used in competition for the first time at AFC#4. Fencers liked the new strips, describing them as "like floating on air". The new pistes are part of NSWFA's Capital Works Program which has also seen the purchase of five new Favero F7 scoreboards, a smarter backdrop for the finals piste, the upgrading of sports flooring around the pistes and a new storage space. These projects have been funded by a \$50,000 Sports Development Program grant from the NSW Office of Sport.



There was a wide range of talent, with fencers as young as 12. And with some of NSW's best fencers taking part, it was a spirited yet friendly competition. Feng Yeng from Feng Fencing and Sinead Elliott from Penrith Fencing Academy took the gold in foil. Taewon Song from Sydney University and Siobhan Elliott from the Penrith Fencing Academy claimed gold in epee."
