

ONLINE COACHING COURSE OPEN



The next round of NSWFA's online Level 1 coaching course for all weapons is **now open** for registration.

With a Level 1 qualification you can teach fencing in schools and clubs - even start your own community club.

The course will involve an online pre-learning component to be completed prior to the practical day which will be on 19th June 2022.

A Level 1 coach will be able to train fencers to a competent level, manage group training sessions and organise teams. The course is suitable for experienced young fencers who can pass on the skills they have learned. It's a good qualification on your CV.

When you pass the online course, you'll receive a certificate. You can then apply to the AFF to be recognised as an Accredited Coach. Coaches who wish to become accredited by the AFF also need:

- A current NSW Working With Children Check clearance. All coaches teaching under 18's must have this. <https://www.service.nsw.gov.au/transaction/apply-working-children-check>
- To complete the free Sport Australia Community Coaching General Principles Course found here: https://www.sportaus.gov.au/coaches_and_officials/coaches
- A current first aid certificate (St John or other authorised provider)

Note: Before registering for the online course, you must be a Junior or Senior Affiliated Member of NSWFA so the accreditation process can be completed.

The cost of the online coaching course for individuals is \$440 (including GST). Additional weapons can be taken for no extra cost. Clubs can sponsor three or more members at a reduced rate. To arrange this, clubs should contact the Simon Capon
