








Commonwealth Fencing Championships The Wrap from London



Looking back on the Commonwealth Championships in London, NSW fencers can be proud of their efforts representing Australia.

In the overall medal tally, Australia finished second to the hosts England, ahead of Scotland, India and Canada.

Of the 5 individual gold medals won by Australians, NSW accounted for 4 of them.

For silver, one of two and for bronze two of 5.

NSW fencers also pulled their weight in the teams events, especially in sabre where our young fencers made up the whole of the teams that won three gold and three bronze medals.

Our star performer was Veronika Vasileva who won two individual golds (Junior & Cadet) and one silver (Senior). Our women's senior sabre team (Veronika plus Gaia Hardge, Yelin Zou and Thi Nguyen) won gold for Senior Women's Sabre. Veronika, Gaia and Yelin went on to also win gold for the sabre Junior & Cadet team categories.

Our men's sabre fencers scored one individual gold (Oscar Shi in Cadets) and three team bronzes (Senior, Junior, Cadet). Well done to Oscar, Sean Andrews, Daniel Iliffe, Leo Kershaw-Kostic, Tarin Liu, Alex Lette and Poom Palakawongse.

A big 'thank you' to coach Alex Andre who guided our young sabre fencers to such outstanding success in London.

Violet Hull fenced well in the Australian team that won bronze in senior women's foil.

Among our veterans, Andrey Tyshchenko won the individual foil gold while Abby Nutt took bronzes in individual foil and epee.

Abby and Annabelle Ballard were in the gold medal winning veteran women's foil team and Abby joined Melissa Yeung in the silver medal winning epee team.

Andrey, Michael Prince and Richard Purdie won bronze medals in veteran foil teams.

Let's also acknowledge the achievements of Queensland's Jacob Crook for his individual silver in senior epee, Victoria's Georgette Sweeney for her bronze in cadet foil and Queensland's Jenny Bonney-Millett for her gold in veteran foil.

Davide Wheeler (Qld), Damian Kneale (WA) and David Chachs (Vic) won gold in veteran sabre teams.

A Parafencing Program

On 23 July, we were delighted to welcome Sarah Skidmore from Paralympics Australia to the Fencing Centre to watch our fencers in action. Sarah will be liaising closely with NSWFA as we develop a Parafencing Program. NSWFA applied for a grant to help advance our parafencing, and we are currently awaiting the results.

President Jing Shang and Vice President Duncan Fairweather showed her around and will be working with Sarah to develop the Program with our Paralympic Coach, Adriano Albano.

NEW Finals Piste!

The AFF's High Performance Commission applied for and was awarded funding from the AIS to establish two National Training



Centres (NTC) one at the Duncan Fairweather Fencing Centre in Sydney and the other at the North Melbourne RC in Melbourne.



The Sydney centre has received a new FIE grade finals piste, fencing dummies, new scoring sets, gym equipment and will be receiving a training video review system.

The Melbourne NTC has also received a new gym with equipment, multiple new pistes, a new finals piste, fencing dummies and will have access to the mobile video review system.

Is Your Working with Children Check Up to Date?

Up to Date?

Anyone in fencing who is engaged in any activity involving children under the age of 18 must have a valid, up to date Working With Children Check certificate.

This is required by NSW law.

In particular, coaches and regular volunteers working with children must have a WWC clearance.

These certificates last for 5 years and can be obtained and updated here:

https://www.service.nsw.gov.au/transaction/apply-working-children-check

If you are paid to provide a service to children, e.g. a coach who accepts money for giving lessons, you'll need the 'Employee' version. It costs about \$80.

If you are a volunteer, choose the 'Volunteer' option. It's free.

Both types involve a National Police Check and a check for any record of reportable conduct.

This can take up to four weeks but is usually much quicker.

Club officials should ensure that any coaches and volunteers regularly working or helping out at their club have a valid WWCC. Clubs should keep a record of WWCC numbers.

Ask them to show you their WWCC certificate.



Is Your Child's Coach WWC Certified?



Parents should also check that their children's coaches have a valid WWCC certificate. Ask them to show you their certificate.

Coaches accredited by the AFF and listed here: https://www.ausfencing.org/list-of-accredited-coaches/ all have valid WWCC certificates.

You can also confirm that your child's coach is WWCC compliant by using 'Check the Check' here:

Coaches should keep their accreditation up to date Accredited coaches should make sure their accreditation is up to date and their name is on the AFF list of accredited coaches here: https://www.ausfencing.org/list-of-accredited-coaches/

If you have been accredited but your name no longer appears on the AFF list, it's likely because your WWCC or your First Aid Certificate has expired. Or perhaps your General Principles of Coaching qualification has expired.

Please log into the AFF Portal to check your credentials.


